

Arbat camp is the biggest camp in Suleimaniyah province. The camp is located outside Arbat sub-district south-east Suleimaniyah. The camp built for Syrian refugees then the IDPs who were remaining in Duhok and Erbil were relocated to the camp. Meanwhile, the camp is fully hosted by refugees and IDPs therefore the camp cannot receive more families.

ETTC, like other international NGOs working in Iraq, has contributed in humanitarian aid for IDPs at the very beginning of the appearance of these conflicts and flee of people to safe places like Kurdistan.

The donation was made by people of Lower Saxony, Germany. There has been several donations made by the people of Lower Saxony and the IDPs were very happy with these supports and they have thanked the donor for being aware of their miseries.

ETTC, on 13th Jan 2015, could provide canned food for **1250** IDP families who were staying at Arbat camp which the total packages weighted **6.25** tons of food. The food packages have been prepared in ETTC compound in Erbil and the distribution arrangements have been done by ETTC office in Suleimaniyah with coordination of Arbat camp management. So far ETTC has provided **6567** food packages and **2030** sweet packages for children which weigh **28.78** tons of food.
